### Support the planning and

Support Park infrastructure

- Support the planning and fundraising of infrastructure projects, such as a covered picnic shelter and / or an observation tower as part of Boardwalk Refurbishment
- Work with park staff to make trails more barrier-free

#### **Trail Monitoring**

- Support the Trail Monitoring Program, including new trails, as they become available
- Expand trail monitoring duties to include some invasive species management, under the direction of Park staff



#### Fundraising and Membership

- Manage the annual canoe raffle, as our primary fundraiser
- Increase membership numbers and engage membership
- Secure donations and grants for infrastructure and special projects





#### **Education and Outreach**

- Increase community engagement, especially with families and seniors, and communicate any new service ideas to the park
- Sponsor and fund special events
- Support Friends' and Park anniversary celebrations
- Increase the Friends' profile

## The 2024 Work Plan includes details for each element:

- 1. Support Park Infrastructure
  - a. Research grant opportunities for Park infrastructure projects such as an observation tower or picnic shelter.
  - b. Support the Park to make trails more barrier-free / accessible as per Ontario Provincial Park guidelines.
- 2. Trail monitoring
  - a. Continue to promote and monitor all trails regularly.
  - b. In support of, and under the direction of Park staff, include the removal of invasive species, such as dog strangling vine, in the trail monitoring program.
- 3. Membership and Fundraising
  - a. Increase canoe raffle ticket sales.
  - b. Investigate other fundraising opportunities, such as a membership drive.
  - c. Increase Friends' membership by active presence at local events including RibFest, Lyndhurst Turkey Fair, other events.
  - d. Liaise with other Friends of Ontario Provincial Parks groups to learn about available grant opportunities and other best practices.
- 4. Education and Outreach
  - a. Continue to manage the annual Seniors' Day event, in collaboration with the Park and the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands.
  - b. Continue to endorse and fund a student to attend the Ontario Nature Youth Summit and fund an annual student bursary.
  - c. Play a role in planning and delivering 2025 anniversary events for the Friends of Charleston Lake Park and supporting Charleston Lake Park anniversary events.
  - d. Appoint a Board member to liaise with the Friends of Charleston Lake Park webmaster.
- 5. Support Park Research Program
  - a. Contribute to and support the Park's Research Plan.
